


## St. John's Parish Directory in Realm & the Realm Connect App Directions to Edit Privacy Settings

If you want verified members of the church to be able to access contact information for you — either on the computer or through Realm Connect — **you must set your privacy settings accordingly.** We encourage you to do this as many parishioners utilize the directory to contact each other.


If you have not already done so, you will need to activate your Realm account (<a href="www.onrealm.org">www.onrealm.org</a>) and/or download the "Realm Connect" app from the App Store or Google Play. If you need another invitation to set up your Realm account or any other assistance, email <a href="mailto:blessings@stjohnsec.org">blessings@stjohnsec.org</a> and someone will reply. (Please be patient as we are working with limited staff this summer.) Staff will also be at the Ministry Fair on Sept. 7th to provide assistance.

## To Set Your Privacy Settings Via Your Computer

- Go to onrealm.org and sign in.
- On the top right corner of the page, click on the photo/photo square. (Please upload a photo if you haven't already.)
- Click on Privacy.
- Under each section, use the drop-down to choose which groups/people can see your contact information. (Example below.)
- Click "Save" in bottom right corner.



## To Set Your Privacy Settings Via Your Phone



- Open the Realm Connect app.
- On the bottom right corner, click on "... More"
- Click on your photo (or circle where you should upload your photo; do that now too!)
- Click on the pencil icon next to each contact item (email, phone, address) and choose the level of visibility you desire.
  - Note: If/when you choose "Anyone in the church" that means verified members only. Everyone must have a log-in to see information in our directory.
- We ask that you choose <u>at least one method</u> of contact to be visible to "Anyone in the church" so fellow parishioners can reach you.
- Click "Save" at the top right.
- Repeat for all methods of contact you wish to edit.
